Saturday 7 May 2011

Return to your hotel, and meet for dinner at the famous Beluga Restaurant, a 5 minute drive from the hotel

Tuesday 10 May 2011

An exciting day for shopping and sightseeing. Spend the morning at the Waterfront shops, and at noon, leave for the famous Table Mountain trip, Signal Hill and a short drive through a local township – enjoy a drink with the locals in their shebeen (pub)

A free evening

Wednesday 11 May 2011

Your time in Cape Town is over, and now time to start moving up the coast, visiting the country's best golf estates. By luxury coach, you will travel to Arabella Golf Estate (just over an hour's drive) – another 5 star experience.

You will spend 2 nights at Arabella, and both evenings enjoy their exquisite cuisine and wines (www.luxurycollection.com/westerncape)

- Thursday 12 May 2011** Your second round of golf on the Arabella course !
- Friday 13 May 2011** Board the luxury coach for Fancourt – in 2004 voted the Best Golf Resort in the World - in the beautiful and scenic Garden Route region, at the foot of the Outeniqua mountains. This will be a 4 hour drive, but one done in comfort, on excellent roads and beautiful scenery.
- Enjoy a welcome cocktail sundowner, overlooking the 18th fairways of both championship courses – the Montagu and the Outeniqua (both designed by Gary Player)
- Fancourt has a variety of restaurants and you will enjoy a different restaurant each evening.

- Saturday 14 May 2011** Your third round of golf on the Championship Montagu golf course – a great test of golf !
- Sunday 15 May 2011** Your fourth round of golf on the Championship Outeniqua golf course – beautiful views !
- Monday 16 May 2011** Still staying at Fancourt, you will travel to the Oubaai golf course (designed by Ernie Els !), for your next round of golf. Situated on the cliffs overlooking the ocean, this is a magnificent experience (www.oubaai.co.za).
- Tuesday 17 May 2011** You will now move on to Knysna, South Africa’s favourite town, about a 45 minute drive from Fancourt, where you will spend the night at the 5 star Simola Golf Estate. This golf course must have the most scenic view of all

golf courses, overlooking the rivers, the lagoon and the Knysna Heads. You will play your final round of golf on Simola. (www.simolaestate.co.za)

Tonight you will travel by coach to nearby Plettenberg Bay to experience one of the region's top restaurants – Emily Moon ! A wonderfully relaxed evening awaits you.

Wednesday 18 May 2011 So here ends your golf, but you now move on to experience two days of an absolute luxury game and bush experience, the 5 star Shamwari Game Reserve, in the Eastern Cape. This will be a 3,5 hour drive, but once again on good roads and lovely scenery. You will arrive at Shamwari shortly after lunch, and immediately be taken on your first game drive. Thursday 19 May 2011 Game drive early in the morning !!! Followed by a day of pampering and relaxation, and a further game drive in the afternoon/early evening. Bring your woollies for the game drives.

Friday 20 May 2011 And here ends your South African experience you will be transferred to Port Elizabeth airport (45 minute drive), fly to Johannesburg and then back to Australia !!!

Important points to note:

- The full cost of the Tour is: Aus \$ 5890 (sharing) Aus \$8 050 (single)
- This price excludes airfares. You would have to book your Australian-South African flights, as well as Johannesburg-Cape Town on arrival and Port Elizabeth-Johannesburg for departure
- The Tour cost includes:
 - All accommodation in 5 star hotels and resorts (bed, breakfast, welcome cocktail parties, dinners – including wine – except for two free nights in Cape Town)
 - All golf (including green fees, golf carts and halfway snacks). If you take a caddy, this will be for your own account
 - All land transport in luxury coach
 - All excursions (Table Mountain, Township tour, Boschendal wine estate)
 - All game drives
 - Prizes for golf events and trophy for the overall winner
- The Tour cost excludes:
